

## **Minutes of a Meeting of Iwerne Minster Parish Council held in the Abingdon Hall on the 4<sup>th</sup> July 2016.**

Present: Cllr J Hooper – Chairman, Cllr M Jones – Vice Chairman, Cllr P Le Prevost, Cllr Evans, Cllr C Nadin and Cllr B O’Luanaigh

**In attendance:** Mrs N Phillips – Clerk, 4 members of the public.

**Public Questions:** It was reported that the website is not working correctly. It was agreed for the Clerk to get the site repaired.

**16/19 To take any apologies:** There were none.

**16/20 Declarations of Interests and Requests for Dispensation.** There were none.

**16/21 Minutes of the meeting held on the 6<sup>th</sup> June 2016.**

The minutes were amended, due to the incorrect date for the next meeting then they were proposed by Cllr Nadin and seconded by Cllr Le Prevost and all members agreed that minutes were a true and accurate record and were duly signed by the Chairman.

**16/22 Matters arising from the minutes.** This will be discussed under officer’s reports.

**16/23 To consider development management matters listed on the schedule.**

**Development Control Matters:**

2/2016/0855/CATREE – The Oak House – tree works. It was agreed to support the tree officer at NDDC decision.

**16/24 To consider 20MPH zone costs**

Cllr Nadin reported that a meeting had taken place regarding the proposed 20MPH zone within the village. Details of the meeting were discussed and debated. Cllr Nadin proposed that the Parish Council, with the financial support from Clayesmore School, agree to finance the project to the maximum sum of £7500.00, which will be paid over 3 years to Dorset County Council. Clayesmore School have agreed to pay £1000.00 each year towards the project. County Council will arrange the necessary advertising to ensure the public are aware of the proposal. This was seconded by Cllr Le Prevost. Cllr Hooper, Cllr O’Connor, Cllr Evans and Cllr O’Luanaigh all in favour, Cllr Jones abstained.

**RESOLVED:** The Parish Council, with the financial support from Clayesmore School, agree to finance the project to the maximum sum of £7500.00, which will be paid over 3 years to Dorset County Council. Clayesmore School have agreed to pay £1000.00 each year towards the project. County Council will arrange the necessary advertising to ensure the public are aware of the proposal. (16/24 – reserved funds)

**16/25 Finance.**

The payment schedule had been tabled, total cost for June 2016, £1031.36. It was proposed by Cllr Le Prevost and seconded by Cllr Nadin that the bills presented on the schedule should be paid.

**16/26 To consider other parish matters.**

**Environmental Protection:** the following report was given by Cllr Nadin:

- To arrange for the stream clean on the 23<sup>rd</sup> July.
- To arrange a working party to clear the bank near the village club.

**Highways:** the following report was given by Cllr O’Luanaigh.

- The overgrown vegetation at Ashgrove has been dealt with.
- Clayesmore School have started clearing vegetation along the boundary of the school.
- Dorset County Council will put two water boxes along Watery Lane at the end of July.
- The area outside the Talbot is still flooding, this will be reported again to Dorset Highways Team.

**Recreation:** The following was reported by Cllr Le Prevost:

- The repaired Iwerne Minster sign opposite the Abingdon Hall has been put back in place.

- Moles have returned to the Play Area. A professional organisation will be asked to come and deal with the moles.
- A working party is needed to help clear the weeds in the Play Area.
- Cllr O'Connor has offered her help, with other volunteers to arrange for the painting of the play equipment. Cllr Prevost will co-ordinate this project.

**Footpaths and Rights of Way:** The following was reported by Cllr Hooper:

- Iwerne Estate has started clearing footpaths on their land. There are still a few that have not been cleared. The Chairman will speak to Susie Lever to chase this matter up.

**Village and District Liaison:** The following was reported by Cllr Jones:

- The X9 bus service may be altered in 2017.
- Details of the new CIL – Community Infrastructure Levy can be found on the Dorset For You website. The public consultation will close on Friday the 29<sup>th</sup> July 2016.
- NHS Dorset Clinical Commissioning Group to their Annual General Meeting on Wednesday 13<sup>th</sup> July 2016 in Wimborne.

**Parish/Neighbourhood Plans:** The following was reported by Cllr Evans:

- The grant for 2016 has been applied for and successfully obtained.
- Residents and land owners in the village have come forward offering land for the Neighbourhood Plan. These will be looked at and discussed with the public at the next public meetings to be held in September.

**Community Resilience & Emergency Planning:** The following was reported by Cllr O'Connor:

- Thanked the Council for sending her on the new Councillor training course.
- Would like to try and collaborate with Clayesmore School to support the Best Kept Village Competition for 2017. The Schools Design and Technology department was contacted and two very skilled A level students have come forward, interested in collaboration. They would like to make a bench that could be placed within the village. Cllr O'Connor gave details of the brief and proposed siting of the bench. She asked for permission to now contact the School to take this project forward. This was agreed by all members.

**Homewatch/Speedwatch:** Cllr O'Luanaigh reported that the speed watch is running smoothly. There are now two NO Excuse signs for the village to be used, showing how many people have been caught speeding in the past month.

**16/27 To consider DAPTC matters.** Nothing to report.

**16/28 To consider any other matters and recent correspondence.**

All correspondence had been circulated and actioned.

The report from Dorset District Council had been circulated, the following was noted:

**Cllr Piers Brown** introduced himself as the newest member of the Hill Forts District Councillor team.

**CIL- Community Infrastructure Levy** public consultation will close on 29<sup>th</sup> July 2016 – details are on the Dorset For You website.

**Dorset Waste Partnership** has removed some types of Bring Banks across the County – full details are on the Dorset For You website.

**Living and learning centres** to be developed after a consultation in 2015 asking Do you think it is a good idea to locate different services, such as care homes, libraries, children centres and day centres in once community building. The majority said they thought it would be a good idea. This project will be taken forward and details will be given once received.

**Cllr Le Prevost** reported that the Queen's Birthday celebrations went very well and the commemorative medals are being delivered to the Children of the Village.

**Cllr Nadin** reported that more advisory signs for HGV drivers will be placed along the A350 and C13 to try and persuade HGV drivers to follow the routes suggested. The A350 group will be meeting with the local MP and Highways personnel, a report will be given after the meeting.
